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Legal Scheduling Made Easy In MedCorr

The latest version of Visual Records' Release of Information (ROI) software system, MedCorr, Version 2.8, includes a new optional module called Legal Scheduling.

The module was specifically developed for Legal Scheduling Departments, so they could easily keep track of and manage legal scheduling information such as physician depositions, court appointments, attorneys, chart orders, invoices and payments. By using the module, users are much more productive and



improve their customer service with physicians, attorneys and other parties they normally work with.

Some of the other benefits of the Legal Scheduling module include:

- A user-friendly interface with a detailed user guide. This eliminates the need for training fees or classes.
- An Appointments feature where users

can schedule and re-schedule appointments quickly and easily.

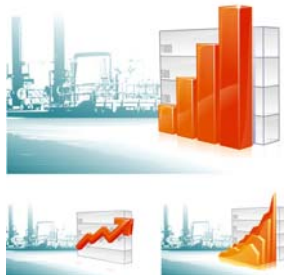
- An Invoices feature allowing users to quickly add and print invoices and enter payments.
- Several form letters that show detailed legal and appointment information for the physicians or attorneys.

MedCorr1 did have a legal scheduling module, which a Kaiser Permanente legal scheduling department in San Diego has been using for several years. Visual Records is currently converting their existing data into MedCorr 2.8.

Since Legal Scheduling is now available in MedCorr 2.8, other Kaiser Permanente legal scheduling departments have expressed interest in purchasing this module.

MedCorr 2.8 also has another module available, Form Filler, which automatically inserts specific patient and request information into documents that are then attached to the patient's record in the program. Examples of these forms include disability claims and attending physician statements from well-known life insurance companies.

Reporting for Duty!!!



The summer has passed so quickly...especially when you are busy with several new projects! Along with supporting our existing software products, we have had several great opportunities to work on consulting and development projects, specifically assisting with reporting and website needs.

An organization that specializes in computer solutions has retained our company as an independent contractor for software development and report writing. We have been requested to create three new Crystal reports for one of their clients, a wholesale distributor and retailer of gasoline, diesel, and other petroleum-related products, and integrate these reports into their existing ERP system. The three new reports are:

- Sales Report
- Inventory Exception Report
- Cardlock Report

The Sales report, which displays specific sales-related information, is generated monthly and can be sorted by one group or several groups such as Customer, Product Category, Sales Representative or Ship to information.

The Inventory Exception report determines if products are listed in two different count sheets and shows product/container, site, product container bin number and count sheet bin number.

The Cardlock report tracks and manages transactions for any card that has three or more transactions in a day and shows card number, transaction time, site, product, quantity and vehicle information.

Patient Portal to the Rescue

On the website side of new projects, we are designing and developing an online patient portal for WellMax, a Center for Preventive Medicine, where patients can access their medical information through WellMax's secure website.

WellMax is a scientifically-based wellness center with comprehensive and state-of-the-art technology, offering the diagnostic capabilities and expertise of a large hospital.
