More Apps Please!

Our first Android mobile application, **VR Mileage Tracker**, was launched on May 17, 2010, and has been well-received at the Android Market. Based on constructive and positive feedback / reviews we received from Android users, we released Version 1.1 of our mileage tracking application in the middle of June.

Some of the new features in Version 1.1 are:

- An Add button so users can auto-fill odometer start miles based on previous records for that vehicle
- New filtering buttons on the main screen (last 30, 60 and 90 days and current year)
- A Statistics page

Due to the success of our first mobile application, we developed a second mobile application called **VR Athlete Tracker**, which was launched on June 17, 2010. The application allows users to track various details of their or their child's athletic events such as:

- Date of event
- Player
- Sport
- Description of the game and Opponent
- Outcome or score
- Rating or Ranking

- Game details / Notes

Users can also take a picture with their cell phone and save it to an event. They can then instantly send an email with the game details and picture to family and friends.

It's a fun way to keep an athletic diary or log and will definitely help our users capture those special, athletic moments in their or their children's lives. With VR Athlete Tracker, it will be so easy to remember great events!

The 411 on MedCorr 2.9

The latest version of our Release of Information software system, MedCorr 2.9, has been finished and is now undergoing Kaiser Permanente's Quality Assurance testing. We expect the testing to go as planned and the version approved, so that it can be released at the beginning of fall. Currently, MedCorr 2.8 is being used by Kaiser Permanente facilities in California.

Our Technology Communications Specialist, Rebecca Phan, spent a few months meeting with the managers and users from the various sites to obtain their valuable feedback as to what new features and changes should be added to this release.

One of the more exciting new features is the Copy Disability and Copy FMLA links. With this new feature, users will be able to copy previous disability or FMLA information to a new request, which will save a lot of time.

Another new feature is the Customize link in the



Correspondence window, where users can customize an existing correspondence letter/template and save their changes.

At the request of Kaiser management, more customizable security features have been put into place so that patient and request information is even more secure and department managers can easily track productivity for each of their staff.

We have also added three new reports for our Legal Scheduling module: A/R Aging, Calendar and Cash Receipts. With the A/R Aging and Cash Receipts reports, users can track what has been invoiced and paid. With the Calendar, users can generate a report showing what legal or deposition appointments are coming up next for easier follow-up.
