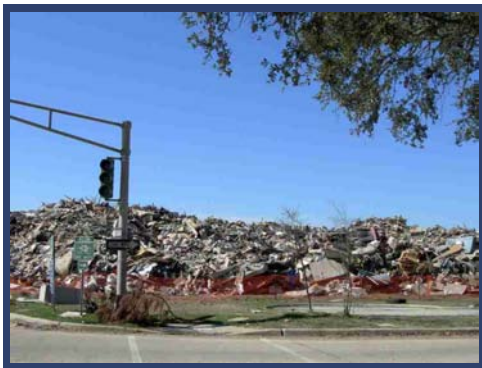

Storm Tracker, our debris ticket tracking software system, is a Windows based program that operates on a computer, laptop or mobile device as a standalone system or using a central database. It has been used since 2002 in Hurricanes Isabel, Charley, Frances, Katrina, Wilma and Rita as well as tornados and ice storms and all over the United States.

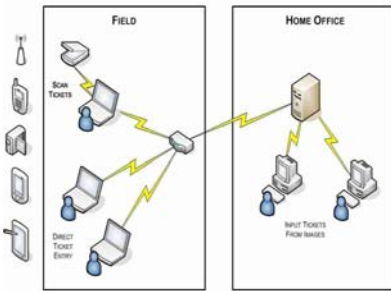
